The theme of the program was make an awareness on “**Education to protect tomorrow**” among the public and communities.

The program was started with tamil thai valthu followed by welcome address delivered by Mr. P. Arasu, II Year B.Sc., Physician Assistant (PA), AHS and he invited all the dignitaries, students and public followed Dr. A.Sundararajan, Vice principal- AHS, SRMIST, delivered the presidential address.
