About the program

The “*World Radiography Day*” program has been conducted on November 8th, 2022, organized by, *Department of Medical Imaging Technology*, College of Allied Health Sciences, Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences, SRM Institute of Science & Technology, Tiruchirappalli campus.

The program has been scheduled between 2.00 pm to 4.00 pm the program preparations were made by the Students of MIT, MIT class advisor & Vice principal. The Theme of the world Radiography Day was “*Evolution of Modern Radiological Equipments with safety aspects*”. Students were divided into 4 teams. Each team comprises of 4 students divided by the class advisor and they had specific topic to demonstrate.

Teams & Topics

Team A : Thermoluminescence Dosimetry
Team B : Fluoroscopy
Team C : Mammography
Team D : Radiation Dose limitations

There were totally 16 poster presentations by each student in every team, 2 instrumentation model, TLD, Lead apron, cassettes, cone and 26 exposed films were placed for visualization, and a full skeleton model to demonstrate the view of exposed image on the X-ray film. The posters, films, models were displayed at the center of the hall, the digital banner was displayed on the projector screen and the hall was decorated by colour balloons.

Mr. S. Ramesh Krishnan, Tutor SRMIST welcomed delivered the welcome address and invited Dr. S. Suresh, Dean OT, Dr. M.
