About the program

Department of Medical Laboratory Technology, College of Allied Health Sciences, SRM Institute of Science & Technology, Tiruchirappalli campus organized a "Blood Donation Camp" on 28.02.2024 from 10.00 am to 4.00 pm at Blood Centre, Trichy SRM Hospital in collaboration with Trichy SRM Medical College Hospital & Research Centre and IMA SRM Irungalur branch.

The theme of the program was to raise awareness about blood can save millions of lives, and young people are the hope and future of a safe blood supply in the world. Blood transfusion is crucial for health care systems, which contributes to rise in life expectancy and quality of life of people experiencing acute critical illness or chronic diseases. Nowadays health care providers manage serious hemorrhagic complications after surgery, delivery or major accidents, severe blood disorders, and oncologic conditions demanding blood transfusion, diagnosis, Treatment and follow-up among students and faculties.

Dr. A. Vijayan delivered the welcome address to Dean and faculty members and students followed by the formal address Dr. A. Sundararajan, Vice Principal, College of Allied Health Sciences delivered the scope of the programme. Dr. N. Balasubramanian, Deputy Director, SRM Trichy campus delivered the presidential address. In his speech, he appreciated the first-time donors for their interest. Dr. S. Revwathy, Dean and Dr. Ravikumar, Medical Superintendent, Trichy SRM Medical College Hospital & Research Centre delivered the felicitation address. All the people filled out the form before donating blood. After that, the program started at 10 am. Many Students and Teachers donated blood and became a part of the program. The blood donation program lasted till 4 pm. 30 volunteers actively participated and donated the blood to save the lives of the needed patients. Few students expressed their happiness for participating the volunteer services. Overall, the camp was coordinated by III Year Medical Laboratory Technology students.

Five Reasons to Donate Blood

- Development of new red blood cells: Within the first 48 hours of blood donation, the donor's body starts replenishing the lost red blood cells. The replenishment process helps in staying healthy and productive at work.
- Reducing risk of heart disease: As per several studies and reports, when there is a rise in the iron level in blood, it raises the chances of heart diseases. People should donate blood from time to time in order to reduce the iron level in the blood.
- *Burns calories:* Donating blood can burn approximately 650 calories for each pint that is like 450 ml of blood.
- *Free blood test:* On donating blood, the donor receives a free mini health screening and blood tests.
- How often can one donate blood?
 The minimum time advised between two donations is 3 months. This gap helps blood regain the normal haemoglobin count.
- Who can donate blood?

The age of the donor must be above 18 years and below 60 years of age. He/shemust have a haemoglobin count that is not less than 12.5 g/dl. The Weigh should not less than 45 kgs. One should have a normal body temperature at the time of donation.

All II-year Medical Laboratory Technology student concluded the program by delivering special thanks Deputy Director, Vice principal, Dean, Medical Superintendent, Assistant Professor, Blood Bank Technicians and all faculty members and students of Allied Health Sciences.
